- Identify pupil's individual learning needs, working closely with EAL, SEND and counselling teams to provide appropriate IEPs and support.
- Participate in staff meetings, professional development and school events.
- Be willing to take on a middle leadership role to lead one area of the curriculum.
- Be committed to parental engagement and community links.
- Be an ambassador for BIST.
