the traditions that shape our identities while learning from one another ❤️💖

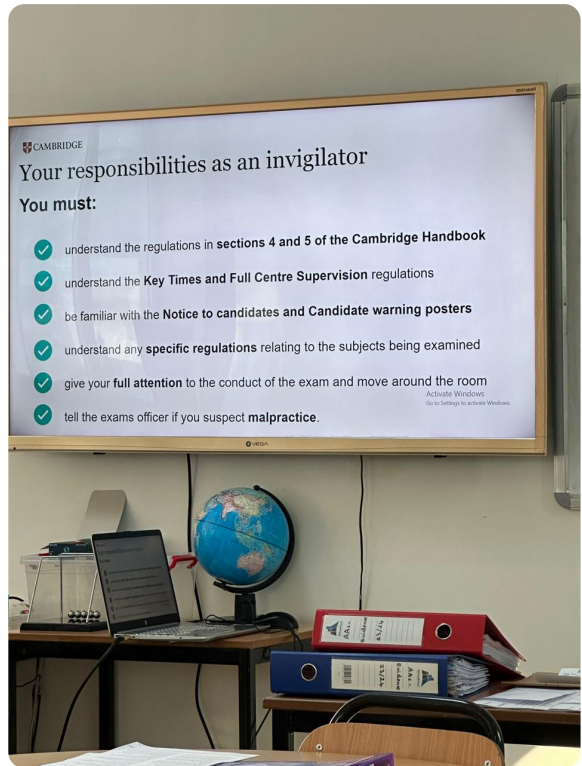
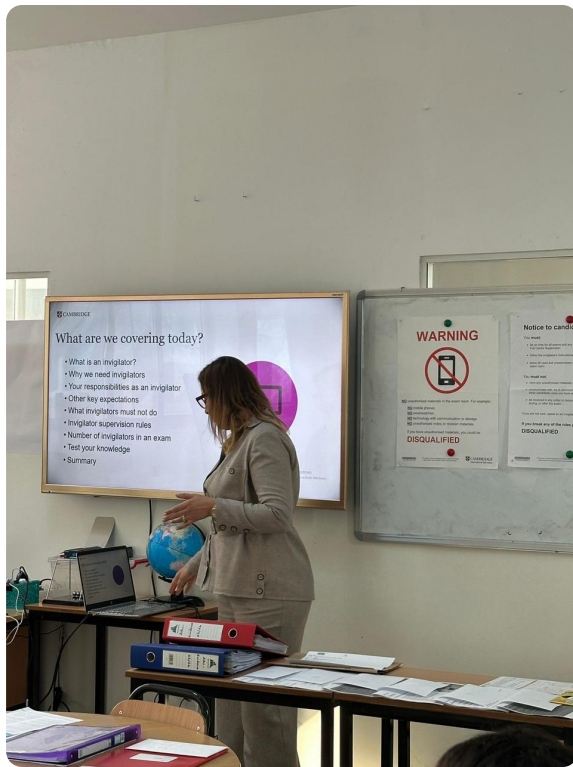


🎓 **Preparing for Excellence: Cambridge Examination Readiness**

Their achievements were celebrated during this morning's assembly, marking a moment of pride for our entire school community 💊

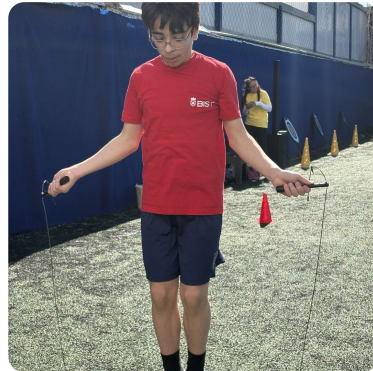


Days of Energy and Team Spirit
