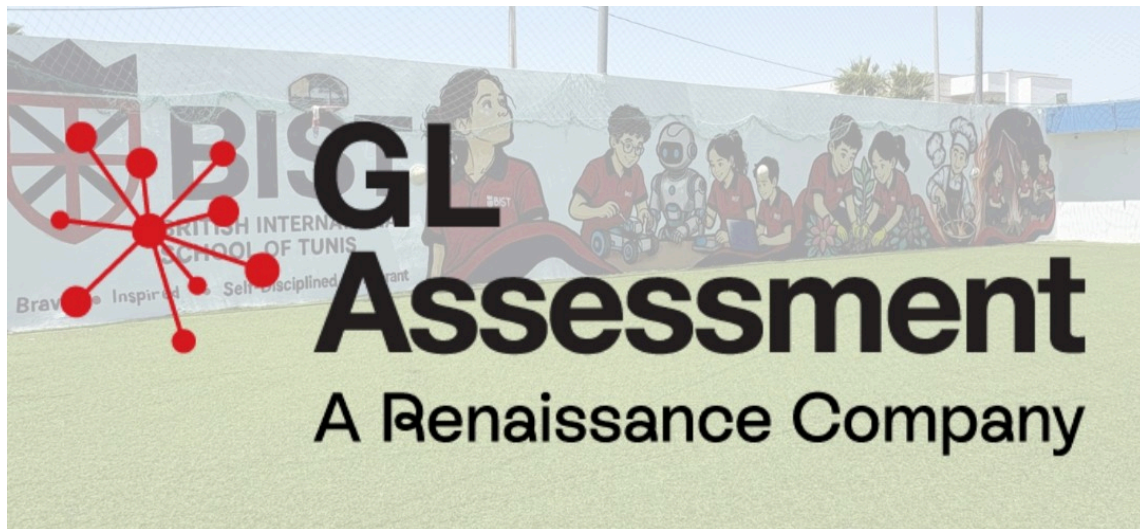
Outstanding GL Assessment Results

This initiative is an important step in helping our pupils develop the skills, knowledge and aspirations they need for their future journeys.



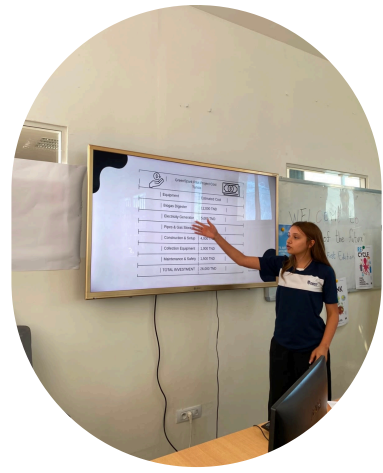
Project-Based Learning Week
